



CONSIDERATION OF NON-URGENT REFERRAL

- Age <60 years with unexplained non-visible haematuria associated with urinary tract symptoms (e.g. loin pain, LUTS).
- Age >= 60 years with recurrent or persistent unexplained UTI.
- Age <45 years with unexplained visible haematuria.

For patients <60 years with asymptomatic non-visible haematuria, a renal USS should be considered.
